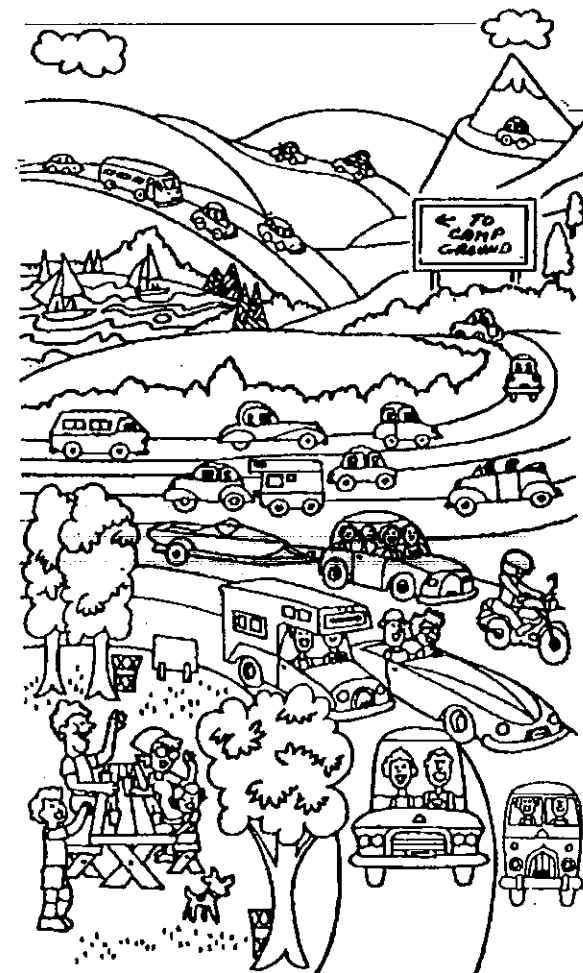

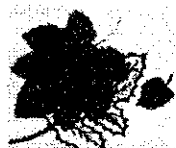

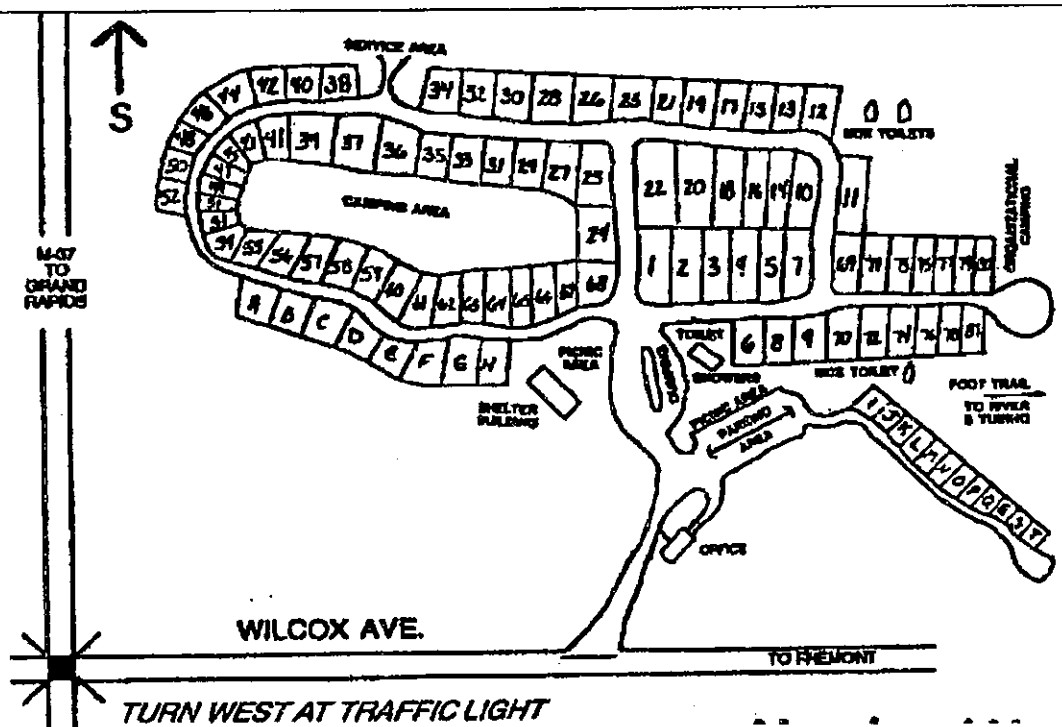

White Cloud Campground Rules

1. Check out time is 2:00 p.m.
2. Quiet time is 10:00 p.m.
3. Dogs allowed only if on leash, attended and cleaned up after.
4. Alcoholic beverages restricted to campsites only.
5. Fires allowed *only* in fire pits.
6. Unlawful to operate off-road motor vehicles.
7. One picnic table per campsite.
8. No cutting of trees in campground.
9. Speed limit 10 mph.
10. Fireworks are prohibited.

Nearby Attractions

FALL COLOR TOUR: White Cloud is the center of the routed color' tour.

GOLF COURSES: Three public golf courses and a driving range are nearby.

BIRDS AND WILDLIFE: Prevalent in the park and surrounding areas.

LODA LAKE WILDFLOWER SACTUARY: Picnic area and hiking trail.

SIDEWALKSALES Third weekend in June the merchants have their annual sidewalk sales.

POW WOW: 2nd weekend in August at White River Dam Park, hosted by White Cloud Chamber of Commerce with Native American Indians and their tribes.

BROWSE: Through our many interesting stores which are within walking distance.

MANISTEE HIKING TRAIL: Starts just south of White Cloud and winds through the county for 20 miles.

HIKING TRAILS: Start in campground to the historic Flowing Well

FLOWING WELL PARK: A municipal public park with natural mineral springs.

BIG PRAIRIE DESERT: Once the largest desert east of the Mississippi River. Now a stately pine forest fully reclaimed.

SMITH PARK & RACEWAY PARK: Nice picnic park on the White River

AIRPORT: Blacktopped, lighted runway, located at the north end of the city.

TENNIS: Public tennis courts at the Elementary school across the street from the park.

HORSEBACK RIDING 5 Miles south of White Cloud

BOWLING: Located at the north end of the City near the airport.

HARDY DAM: Impoundment of the Muskegon River is the largest inland body of water in Michigan. Beautiful view, good sail boating and water skiing

NEWAYGO & HESPERIA: Enjoy An exciting canoe trip. Canoe rentals nearby.

LITTLE SWITZERLAND: Scenic area located around chain of lakes south of the city.

SAILORS VIRGIN PINE FOREST: Located near Croton. It is the only remaining stand of virgin pine in the area
